Dear Colleagues,

The European Course in Plastic Surgery will be organised for the third time in Berne, Switzerland. Looking back, the courses matured considerably with time. The quality of talks improved by giving more time to the speakers and more time for the discussions. The faculty became larger with a good mix of national and international speakers that come from most of the European countries.

The intention of the Course is to give an overview of the plastic surgery while covering most of the topics of the plastic surgical syllabus. For more experienced participants the Course will be an interesting refresher.

The city of Berne, the Swiss capital, is perfectly located almost in the centre of Europe. It is accessible by flight through airports of Zurich, Geneva and Basel. You'll find train stations in the basement of Zurich and Geneva airports. There are excellent connections by train and by modern highways. For those arriving by train there is a door-to-door tram connection from the railway station to the Novotel hotel.

The venue of the Course will be the Novotel Hotel in Berne. In fact in the same building there are three hotels: Novotel, Ibis and Ibis Budget. The participants can select the accommodation in one of the hotels depending of their respective budgets. The three day Course, coffee breaks and lunches will take place in Novotel hotel.

Included in the Course fee of 900€ is the participation to the Course, extended abstracts that will be sent to the paying participants one month in advance in electronic form, lunches, coffee breaks, a welcome reception at Novotel on October 31st and Course dinner for participants and lecturers on November 2nd.
